

Materials needed:

1. Android device (phone or tablet) that will be used for scanning ID's.
2. Internet connection.

Steps:

- 1) Use the link to download the latest version.
- 2) Run the My Files app (search for "files" if you can't find it). Note that on phone brands other than Samsung, the files app might have a different name.
- 3) In the files app, go to the downloads directory.
- 4) Find the Android CRC eCS app. It will be named something like "crcecs-release1.2.3.apk"
- 5) Click on it.
- 6) If you get a message that your phone isn't allowed to install unknown apps from this source, click on Settings and turn on "Install unknown apps" for your files app.
- 7) Click install or update, depending on whether you already have a version installed.
- 8) When the installation is done, you can click "Open" to run the app immediately, or "Done" if you want to run it later.

NOTE: The first time you run the app, you will need to grant it camera permission. "While using the app" is the appropriate response.
